**ADDED LAND, NATIVE SOD, CRP, & PASTURE:** Different rules apply to the different categories. If you have **added land, changed land, or taken land out of Native Sod, CRP, or PASTURE**, please call us. It is best if you get us the total number of acres and the FSA maps **BEFORE APRIL 30<sup>th</sup>**. You can add land at any time. If it is added after April 30<sup>th</sup>, you may be stuck with the County T-yield instead of your simple average or may only qualify for 65% of the County T-yield if the proper forms and notices are not given.

### PREVENT PLANT & REPLANT:

In the event you are **PREVENTED** from planting an insured crop, you **MUST** notify us so we can submit a claim. If claims are not reported, within 72 hours after the final plant date, the claim will be **DENIED**.

If you have **REPLANT**, please notify us before you start, so we can get a claim turned in. You must notify us before you replant, whether you expect a claim to be paid or not. When you report REPLANT to FSA make sure you give them the first plant date and the replant date. These dates will affect your crop insurance. You must also notify us if you are just filling in spots. All claims made after the fact are **DENIED**. Exceptions are not made to these rules. It is better to file a claim and withdraw it later, than to have a valid claim denied.

### REMINDERS:

You have until **July 15<sup>th</sup>** to report your certified acres to FSA and to our office. Both offices would like you to certify as soon after you are done planting as possible. If any mistakes are found, by either office, we can get them corrected before the July 15<sup>th</sup> deadline. Mistakes found after the July 15<sup>th</sup> deadline will not be as easy to fix by either office. Please bring us a copy of the FSA **All Farms Summary** and FSA maps when you report your planted acres to us. If the FSA has a unit marked as irrigated and you do not intend to irrigate, you will need to ask them to change the practice to non-irrigated. We have to match what the FSA has on their report.
