Market Updates

Corn and soybean projected prices are about to be discovered. Projected price will be calculated using the average daily closing price of the following futures contracts on the Chicago Board of Trade during the trading days of February:

CORN: December 2023 contract opened at \$ 5.96 as of 2/1/23

SOYBEANS: November 2023 contract opened at \$ 13.60 as of 2/1/23

Crop insurance sign up deadline is March 15. Set up an appointment, stop in the office or call for any needs today. Spring prices are not official until March 3rd.

Recipe of the Month
